## **Profile**

Yu Kuwabara (b.1984, Chiba, Japan) is a Japanese composer, a researcher of Japanese traditional arts, living in Tokyo. She makes music to ask herself who she really is. For several years, she has been researching and studying traditional Japanese music and arts to extend as far back as possible to her origins, in order to confirm her own standing. She has collaborated with numerous artists and instrumentalists of Japanese art forms including a Rakugo performer Kokontei Shinsuke (Japanese traditional verbal entertainment), Koto performers' groups Tsugukaji-Koto and 4plus (Japanese zither), Japanese Buddhist chant group Shomyo no Kai - Voice of a Thousand Years to have investigated her own musical form between the past and the present, and also between Japan and the world.



Yu Kuwabara's works have been performed at numerous important international festivals (Darmstädter Ferienkurse, Ultraschall Berlin, CRESC... Biennale für Aktuelle Musik Frankfurt Rhein-Main, Festival 20/21 Transit, Mostra Sonora Sueca, EXPO Milano 2015, Music From Japan, Tongyeong International Music Festival, Takefu International Music Festival, and others) and in many other concerts around the world with various ensembles and performers (Ensemble Modern, Trio Accanto, soloists from Ensemble Intercontemporain, Talea Ensemble, Enno Poppe and Klangforum Wien, mdi ensemble, Ensemble Proton Bern, Divertimento Ensemble, Mike Svoboda and neuverBand, loadbang, AsianArt Ensemble, Sentieri selvaggi, Ensemble Mise-en, Tokyo Philharmonic Orchestra, Nicolas Hodges, William Lang, Claire Chase, Rebekah Heller, Stefan Hussong, Camilla Hoitenga, Toshiya Suzuki, Kosei Murata, Hidejiro Honjoh, and others). Her music is published by Edition Wunn, Germany. She is a composer of Awai-Za, a chamber ensemble mixed with new music and Japanese Edo culture. Her first portrait concert "Shadowless - Yu Kuwabara Portrait [Awai-Za Recital Series Vol.1]" (→concert report in Japanese) held at Tokyo Opera City Recital Hall on July 19, 2019, was highly acclaimed.
